

### LIBRARY LEVY RENEWAL



THE PLYMC LEVY WILL BE ON THE BALLOT NOV. 5, 2024 2.4-MILL RENEWAL - NOT A NEW TAX

The Public Library of Youngstown & Mahoning County (PLYMC) is seeking a 5-year renewal of a 2.4-mill levy during the general election on November 5, 2024. This is the same term and millage voters approved in 2019.

The levy accounts for nearly half of the funding of the Library. The funds are used to maintain locations, services and programs at all PLYMC branches in Mahoning County.

The Library operates debt-free, spends carefully and saves for projects. Planning for the future means no interest-bearing loans and represents savings for the taxpayer.

Remember to register to vote by October 7 to vote in the general election. Check your registration at voteohio.gov. For more information about the levy, go to libraryvisit.org.

Registration is required for some programs and each attendee must be registered. For programs on Zoom, register with an email address through the events online calendar.


